

All Surface Water Diversion Customers -



Per California State law, all surface water diverters, must have a meter that meets state standards. The District is putting all meters into compliance at District cost. If your meter is currently inoperable, please contact the District immediately.

If you're not currently using surface water but have a diversion available for use, please contact the District so we can work concurrently with you to provide surface water supply.

ATTENTION: The Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) law may seriously affect Landowner irrigation practices in the near future, up to and possibly including having to fallow land. The District is eager to partner with Landowners to convert from using groundwater to surface water.
